## Haute Couture with LIFTEUROP



The company LIFTEUROP, founded in 2010 in Wiltz and part of the Alipa Group, which specialises in the development and manufacture of equipment and lifting accessories, has just acquired a new sewing machine for its textile factory.

After creating a new website ([www.lifteurop.com](http://www.lifteurop.com)) and a new catalogue in 2013, this investment confirms the efforts of management to optimise the commercial development of LIFTEUROP and enhance product quality.

Since its inception in 2010 following the acquisition of the French STAS (Société Technique d'Accessories Spécialisés) LIFTEUROP has continued to invest in its production as well as in research and innovation to enable it achieve its ambitions - to make the STAS brand outside the Hexagon and develop its international activities.

A new sewing machine textile now completes a set of production machines already in production.

"The sale of textiles accounts for 10% of our sales. We strive to sew the fabric with the utmost care by experience and expertise specific to the STAS brand. We take care to provide our customers with perfect hardware finishes, attention they particularly enjoy," said Gaëtan Lambert engineer and technical manager.

To ensure the safety of goods and persons, LIFTEUROP sews its textiles according to a specific development plan. "We do not compromise with security, the seams must be made perfectly for carrying the maximum load (CMU). The thread used is polyamide, resistance is regularly tested on a special strength bench" explained Michael Magerotte, head of production. "By their nature, textile seams are susceptible to wear and nicks that dangerously affect their resistance. To protect them, we can, according to customers' requests, sew a nylon fabric seam and/or protect it with a removable protective sheath," he added.

In order to optimise traceability, LIFTEUROP offers its customers the opportunity to incorporate into the seams, an RFID chip that can contain an individual traceability code and customised according to the request of the user.
